S ometimes writing an article for the Telegram is easy but sometimes, like for this one, I seem to struggle with what to say or to write. I actually wrote one article, went home and the next day I re-read it and decided I didn't like what I had written. Interesting though, is that I was involved in a conversation with one of our female residents that morning, and it suddenly dawned on me, here is my article!

This young girl was being "snippy" and disrespectful to her housemom. She didn't understand why she had to listen to someone that "isn't my mother". The fact is, her biological parents had chosen drugs and alcohol over being a parent to this girl. She was placed in several foster homes and in the one before her placement at Shults-Lewis, she was abused.

As the Program Director talked to this resident about what she was feeling, the girl talked about the ways she was "just like" her mom and/or dad. You see, she had just visited with her caseworker and had found out some personal information on her biological parents. She needed to belong to someone, to connect with those who are supposed to take care of us as children and guide us into adulthood.

During the conversation, the Program Director told her that she was important to God and she was very important to us here at Shults-Lewis. I chimed in and told her that she was a special girl and that God does not make junk. She teared-up and softly said, "No one has ever told me I was important before." My heart just hurt for this young girl. Can you imagine living your childhood



up to age 12/13 years and never hearing the words like you are important, you are special, and even more important, hearing the words you are loved?

It is teens like this that we work with here at Shults-Lewis. And it is these teens and their stories like these that tell me how important this ministry is in our chaotic world today. For most of the staff here, it is so hard to imagine being brought up in a family filled with drugs, alcohol, and total chaos. It is stories like this that make our jobs so fulfilling but at the same time, so heartbreaking.

God has blessed us greatly with the resources to continue this important ministry. I thank all of you for your support, prayers, and donations that enable us to carry this work forward.
