has certainly put a damper on what we are able to do with the children. Nonetheless, everyone had a wonderful and festive time during the holidays.

It seems unreal that we are now into a 'New Year.' Shults Lewis has such wonderful donors. We are so blessed to be partners in our work with such loving, generous people. Your love and support for our children is nothing short of amazing. It can never be understated, that without you, we could not do what we do.

Our goal with family therapy is that when the children go back home the same disruptive dynamics will not occur in the home. Reunification is always our goal, if possible.

Donors, thank you, thank you, thank you for everything that you do to help us. I can truly say that the individuals that I work with, do their jobs because of their love for the children. Please pray that there is an end or answer to this virus, so that we are able to get back to 'normal' (whatever that is going to look like) soon. The House Parent applicants should meet the following minimum requirements:

- · Faithful member of the Church of Christ
- Strong passion for the mission of Shults-Lewis
- A high school diploma, preferably some experience working with teenagers
- · Couples should be married at least 3 years
- · Good organization skills
- · Valid driver's license
- Be able to provide spiritual leadership to teen residents
