Transitions

It seems like things are slowly getting back to "normal" here on campus as well as in the world. It is sometimes hard for me to imagine not grabbing my facemask before I go into the grocery or when going OUT to eat somewhere. We have been blessed however, during this past year. Our churches and donors never stopped their donations and just kept on giving us loads of commodity items. Shults-Lewis is so thankful for all of you who give to us so generously even during times of crisis. We only had one houseparent couple and one resident to contract covid during the past year and a half. God certainly watched over all of us here and he continually blesses us.



There is currently federal legislation that is making it very hard for smaller, faith-based agencies like Shults-Lewis to continue their mission. There are rules that we cannot possibly afford to comply with both financially and physically. The Shults-Lewis Board of Trustees has agreed that Shults-Lewis needs to take the necessary steps to become financially independent of the Department of Child Services (who currently licenses and contracts with us) and to become a private child caring institution. We are currently in the process of making plans for how we can become financially solvent. You will be hearing more about this as we proceed, but I would like to ask all of our supporters to pray for us during this transitional period.

The book of Ecclesiastes talks about there being a time for everything, a time for every event under heaven. I believe it is time for me to retire as Executive Director of Shults-Lewis. I have prayed and asked God for his infinite guidance in making the right decision. I plan to retire at the end of this year. The reasons for this decision are many but I truly believe it is the right decision for my family and me. This has been probably the most challenging job of my career, while at the same time, it has been one of the most rewarding. I work with wonderful Christian staff who have a love – as I do – for this ministry. The children we care for are very dear to me. You always wonder if what you are doing makes a difference in their lives. More often than not, you do not see that difference until 5 to 10 years down the line. Nevertheless, I truly believe Shults-Lewis makes a difference in every single child that we meet.

My prayer is that God will continue to bless Shults-Lewis and its ministry for MANY more years. I thank all of our wonderful donors for their prayers and continual support. It has been an honor to serve in this capacity these past 3 years. I will continue to pray for all the staff and children as I transition to a new adventure in my life.
